IMPLEMENTATION REPORT

“Gerelt Mur” is a non-profit NGO established in 2006 with the aim to promote education opportunities for young people from vulnerable families and provide housing and clothing for impoverished families.

Within 3 years since its establishment “Gerelt Mur” has provided more than 20 families with gers making lots of quality differences in their lives.

We received 2000\$ from Gaden Relief in spring of 2009 and decided to build up gers for homeless and poor families with this money.

This time we had chosen 2 poor families without their own home. Each family has 4 people in their household.

The first family we had chosen is a single mother - headed family with 3 children aged from 2 months to 15 years old. The oldest daughter in this family is disabled. The mother has no regular job. They lived in a rent ger.

The second family is a young couple with two children aged from 5 months to 6 years old. We had chosen this family because we wanted to support the young teachers working in the secondary school of outskirts of Ulaanbaatar, where more children from vulnerable families are enrolled. This young couple were living with the wife`s parents family along with 7 other family members, totally 12 people including them.
